Background and Learning Objectives

Incidence of benign, pre-malignant and malignant anal lesions required diffuse practice in diagnosis and treatment of these conditions, consequent to human papilloma virus (HPV) infection. Some populations are at higher risk of HPV infection and, then, anal cancer. For these reasons, colorectal surgeons need to be trained in accurately perform screening tests and, in particular, high-resolution anoscopy (HRA) leading the identification of anal intraepithelial neoplasia (AIN) and, when indicated, either targeted ambulatory or operative treatment of the anal cancer precursors.

Upon completion of this Course, the participant should be able to:

- Describe the epidemiology and pathology of anal HPV infection, Anal Intraepithelial Neoplasia (AIN), and anal cancer;
- Identify patients who may benefit from anal cancer screening;
- Demonstrate the diagnostic procedures used in the evaluation of AIN and anal cancer including anal cytology, high resolution anoscopy, and anal biopsy;
- Describe and apply the appropriate treatment and management options for AIN and anal cancer;
- Describe and apply prevention options for AIN and anal cancer.
